There are 7 levels in the core curriculum, from English 110 to English 145. It takes approximately 2 months to complete each level.



Smrt English (ESL)

ABOUT

Smrt English (ESL) is designed to encourage students to work together as a way of using English in a real and meaningful way. Fully utilizing the Smrt curriculum and other digital tools, these courses enable students to develop listening, speaking, reading and writing skills to function in most real-life situations.

Length

You can choose any length between 1-52 weeks. Most students study 12, 24, 36, or 48 weeks and then go on to take another course such as Business English, IELTS Preparation, University Pathway or Canadian College Business Management program.

English Level Requirements

There is no requirement to join General English. You will take a placement test on the first day of school and start from the most suitable level. It takes an average of 2 months to advance to the next level.

Business English

English for Presentation and Public Speaking (EPP)

This course is suitable for students who would like to learn strategies for and build confidence in speaking and presenting in front of small or large audiences.

You will learn how to:

- organise your ideas for a professional presentation
- create slides to support your presentation
- deliver an effective and engaging presentation
- use appropriate body language
- ask and answer questions effectively

English for the Workplace (EWP)

This course is beneficial for students who want to communicate effectively and confidently at an English-speaking workplace.

The course covers topics including:

- communicating in the workplace
- participating in business meetings
- writing business emails
- participating in business conversations
- making appointments

Upon successful completion of both courses, students can transfer credits to **COMM140 - Communications at Canadian College.**

English Level Requirement

Students are required to have an ENGL120 level (equivalent to IELTS 4.5) in order to take Everyday English for Health & Wellness.

- Need to understand doctors, pharmacists, and health-related instructions
- Are not in the medical field but want to communicate about health in everyday life

- IELTS is widely available and globally accepted.
- IELTS is trusted by individuals and organisations around the world for its fairness, reliability and high-quality standards.
- IELTS offers test takers a choice to take the Listening, Reading, and Writing sections of the test on computer or paper
- IELTS is the only English language test where the Speaking test is a one-on-one session with an examiner in a private room, where you will not be interrupted by other test takers.
- IELTS results are available in 5-7 days (computer-delivered) and 13 days (paper-based)
- There is no pass or fail in IELTS. The score you need is determined by the organization you are applying to.

EAP & University Pathway

ABOUT

Our EAP (English for Academic Purposes) program, ENGL 140 and 145, is designed for students planning to enter a Canadian college or university. These courses have a strong focus on writing, listening and reading skills, and aim to give students a deep understanding of a variety of essay-writing styles.

Conditional Admission

After completion of the EAP pathway program, students can enter several Canadian universities without TOEFL or IELTS exams. Students must apply separately with all supporting academic documents for entry into our partnered universities but CCEL staff will assist with this process.



English Level Requirement

To be accepted into ENGL140, students must pass ENGL125 or score 60% on our ENGL130 exam. Students with an IELTS of 5.5 are also permitted. In order to take ENGL145, students must successfully complete ENGL140.



English 140

University preparation with a focus on writing, listening and reading skills. Developing thesis statements and a deep understanding of Comparison/ Contrast, Cause/Effect and Effect essay styles. Introduction to academic vocabulary and rhetoric while developing critical thinking skills.



English 145

This EAP course is a continuation of EAP 140. Students further develop their abilities to collect and synthesize information from a variety of academic sources; analyze and critique materials; and present their ideas in a variety of media in accordance with the academic standards found at the first-year university level.

Our friendly airport transfer specialist can meet the student at Vancouver Airport and drive them to CCEL residence or the homestay family.




