English language courses for Adults

Choosing to study English abroad could be one of the most important decisions you will ever make!

Academic Year courses (Study and work)

These long-term programmes, aimed at non-EU students, are designed to allow progression through one to two levels, over an academic year period and to gain a professional, internationally-recognised English qualification.

Students also have the option of working part-time (see below).

Intensive English Courses

In addition to the General English courses, this 25-hour per week course includes 10 specialized elective lessons. You can choose these elective lessons upon your arrival, tailoring the programme to your specific interests and needs.

Business English courses

This course enhances language skills for professional contexts, focusing on business communication needs. It covers topics such as business terminology, email writing, presentations, meetings, and negotiations.

English courses for teachers (Erasmus+)

Choose the perfect living space for a comfortable and enjoyable stay




Student Residence
