



Intensive Courses

Fluency / Academic Skills

This is a 12-module, topic-based course in which students can rapidly improve their speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Each week students focus on vocabulary and grammatical structures related to a specific topic and perform practice exercises related to the four skills. The classes are level based so students can move to higher levels as their skills improve. This means students who wish to study longer and consolidate and expand their knowledge of a particular area, can do so without repeating any material.

Motivating materials and imaginative, knowledgeable teachers ensure that students will find the course highly rewarding.

Afternoon 10

For those who are short of time or may be working, Afternoon 10 gives you the perfect opportunity to brush up on your conversation skills, Business English or prepare for a range of examinations.

Evening Courses

LSI's evening courses (Auckland only), have been designed to cater for students who, due to work or study commitments, are unable to enrol on one of our daytime courses. All evening courses offer structured language classes that cover grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation, as well as developing the four key skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening).

Plus Courses – One-to-one

English For 30+

The English for 30+ programme is a topic-based programme tailored for students aged 30 and above. Each week, students will delve into a distinct topic area with a corresponding grammatical focus. The learning journey encompasses a comprehensive approach where vocabulary and grammar are systematically developed, revisited, strengthened, and interwoven, aligning seamlessly with the intended design of the course materials.

The English for 30+ programme is ideal for students who prefer learning alongside peers of a similar age group, with classes that also explore cultural themes, practical communication strategies, and contemporary topics.

Professional Development / Certificate Courses

Business English 20

English for Teaching

Aimed at speakers of other languages, this course equips students with the basic tools required to teach English as a Foreign Language.

Option 1: For Individuals

- General 20 (Intensive English) (16.7 hours) plus 5 or 10 individual lessons per week
- Individual lesson: 45 minutes (in the USA 50 minutes)
- Intermediate to Advanced levels

Option 2: Closed Group tuition

English for Public Speaking & Presentations

Our 4-week English for Public Speaking & Presentations course is specifically designed for ESL learners at the B1+ level or higher.

Throughout this programme, you will learn how to plan, structure, and deliver successful presentations in English, while gaining confidence, becoming more articulate in front of an audience, and improving English pronunciation.

Through a combination of interactive activities and practice sessions, you will learn how to engage your audience with conviction and express yourself clearly in English. LSI will provide guidance and feedback to enhance your overall delivery, ensuring that your message is conveyed with impact and professionalism. You will acquire valuable strategies to enhance your stage presence.

Module 1: Purpose and Audience

- Identifying purpose, creating a main message and involving the audience

Module 2: Structure

- Structuring a presentation, signposting and giving examples

Module 3: Creating Impact

- Using stories, giving a demonstration and persuasive techniques

Module 4: Delivery

- Pace, body movement and gesture. Individual final presentation on student's chosen topic

The English for Public Speaking programme consists of 10 lessons per week in small classes with a maximum of 5 students in London Central and Toronto, and of 6 students in Auckland. Each lesson is 50 mins. Each week includes 8.33 hours of teacher contact time. The English for Public Speaking classes can be taken in addition to G20, LSI's general English classes, or can be booked independently.

Aviation English

This course covers all the ground theory required to gain a private or commercial pilot's licence. Practical flying sessions can also be arranged with a partner flying school at extra cost.

Courses for Kids and Teenagers

Our language classes feature engaging activities that emphasise communication and the core skills (Speaking, Writing, Reading and Listening) whilst building knowledge of key grammar and vocabulary.

Materials are designed specifically for kids and teenagers and offer interesting project based activities via a topic based syllabus.

Future Leaders

As well as General English courses for juniors, LSI offers a Future Leaders programme where students develop transferrable skills crucial to succeed in later life. These are life and career skills including: leadership, responsibility, initiative, and resilience; as well as critical thinking, collaboration and communication skills.

Core English lessons improve students' receptive and productive language skills and develop their ability to communicate effectively in English. But as well as refining and deepening the students' knowledge and application of the English language, this course looks ahead to their adult life. Three carefully designed workshops per week develop the leadership skills considered to be important not only for business managers but also for any role that require working in a team &/or managing other people. This is a course designed to prepare ambitious, more mature teens for a global, competitive and fast-changing world.

In addition, students participate in a varied cultural and social activity programme appropriate to their age. These activities improve knowledge of the local way of life, encourage the respect of other people's cultures, and help to motivate students to carry on studying English after they leave the course. Activities are organised and supervised by LSI staff and allow students to enjoy and strengthen their new friendships in a more informal, relaxed and sociable setting.

Student Welfare

The safety and well-being of students in our care is our top priority. All LSI centres work with local and national agencies to ensure that we maintain the highest industry standards in safeguarding and child safety.

Students are supervised both in the classroom and on social activities. School staff are available to both students and parents at all times. LSI also provides trained welfare officers in all our schools to offer any additional support required by the students.

Security is also a priority when selecting the right kind of accommodation for our Junior students. LSI homestays are carefully selected and regularly visited by a trained member of staff, while our student residences provide 24 hour supervision.

In Canada, for students under the age of 18 travelling without a parent or guardian and coming from countries requiring visas to enter Canada, Canadian embassies may require custodianship forms. LSI offers custodianship services.

To ensure student welfare there is a 10pm* curfew, unless students are on a supervised LSI activity. Valuables such as passports and airline tickets may be left with the centre manager on the student's first morning, to be kept securely locked in the school.



Student Welfare & Safeguarding

- School Student Welfare & Safeguarding policies and procedures are evaluated by local accreditation agencies
- Each school has dedicated Student Welfare & Safeguarding Officers
- LSI homestays and staff are subject to background checks
- Students have strict curfew times
- The school has a 24 hour emergency telephone number
- Students must sign a code of conduct. This ensures safety, enjoyment of the course for all participants and protects against bullying, both in school and on-line

Please note, students are not supervised by LSI staff on journeys to and from school and on journeys home from activities.

Social and Cultural Programmes

To compliment our language programme for kids and teenagers, we offer an exciting mixture of fun social activities to make sure your child gets the most from their stay.



These fun, educational activities ensure that our young learners develop their language skills both inside and outside the classroom. They will discover more about their host country, the culture and people. They will mix with their peers from around the world, making new friends and practicing the language in a natural environment.

Our structured activities are fully supervised allowing parents and guardians to have complete peace of mind. 

Homestay Accommodation

Our students stay with carefully selected homestay hosts in the neighbourhoods around the language school. Some hosts are further away, but commutes are generally simple and will be explained on the first day by homestay hosts. Meals are provided every day and laundry, towels and bed linen will be changed weekly.

Students stay in twin rooms and are matched by age and gender. When possible, we match students from countries where different native languages are spoken. If we have an odd number of students booking twin rooms, it is possible that a student may stay in a single room for no added cost. Residential Accommodation

LSI operates residence based summer camps for kids and teenagers in a number of locations around the world.
