

Your learning

Our approach to teaching is focused on helping you achieve your personal goals, which we do through:

Your class

Before you start your course at St Giles, you will take an online placement test so we can make sure you are placed in the right class. You will then be put in a class with students who have a similar level of English and, where possible, are from a variety of countries.

At St Giles, we have a maximum class size of 12 at our year-round centres and 15 at our Junior centres. For even smaller class sizes, students can opt for our Platinum classes (available at selected locations). The minimum age is 21, and the maximum class size is 5. This means that you will enjoy personal attention from your teachers, which will help you make faster progress.

- A one-to-one feedback meeting with your teacher every two weeks
- An in-class test every two weeks


We want to make sure our students are safe and happy during their time with us, so we provide:
