Tuition Fees:

Fees apply only when full payment is made in advance for the entire course duration.

Accommodation Fees:

2026 rate will be applied to accommodation starting or extended between **28 December 2025 and 27 December 2026**.

COURSE BREAKS

General English students on longer courses may take short study breaks:

› Courses of 9+ weeks:

One-week break (Monday–Friday) allowed after 8 weeks of study.

› Courses of 24+ weeks:

One-week break for every 12 weeks of study (max. 2 weeks at a time)

Students must ensure that arrangements comply with their visa conditions, where relevant. Students should select this option and choose dates at the time of enrolment to avoid problems with visas or payment of amendment fees.

Students requesting course breaks or changes to course breaks after arrival, must give 4 weeks' notice of requirements, which are subject to availability.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Please note: Courses run from Sunday to Sunday. All prices are based on arrivals and departures on Sundays. Arrival and departure on other days is only available at limited centres and is subject to availability.
